

2015 Linda Falls Cabernet Sauvignon

Linda Falls Cabernet Sauvignon Tucked amongst the redwoods and hills, the seven acres of the organically farmed Linda Falls Vineyard captures the rugged beauty of the Howell Mountain appellation. Stretching above the fog at an average elevation of 1,500 feet, this area is known for well-drained, volcanic soils and a cooler climate which results in wines with distinct structure. Our timeless vinification techniques lend themselves to crafting elegant and balanced wines that purely convey the vintage driven expression of this mountain vineyard.

The 2015 Vintage was known for its unusually warm weather which lead to reduced yields at harvest. Luckily those reduced yields resulted in impeccable quality of fruit. This vintage expresses great depth of flavor and intensity, which offers a truly memorable wine drinking experience right now and will continue to shine many years in the future.

The Palate of the 2015 Linda Falls is unlike any other wine that we produce. The elevation, soil, and aspect force the grapes to struggle. This hardship produces a wine of incredible density and structure, magnified by the characteristics of the vintage. The combination of tart and ripe black and red fruits with high mountain herbs of juniper and Douglas Fir make this one of the most unique expressions of pure Cabernet Sauvignon in the world.
